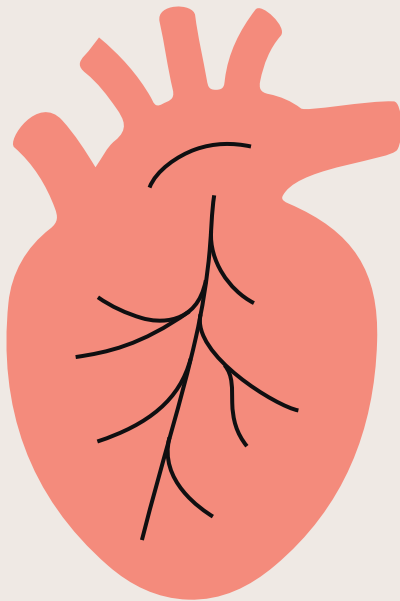


six facts about congenital heart disease (CHD)



- Most common type of birth defect
- 1 out of 100 infants impacted
- 25% of CHDs require surgery or a procedure within a baby's first year of life
- About 95% of children with a non-critical CHD survive until at least 18 years of age
- 3 million+ children and adults are living with CHD
- Common CHDs include:
 - Bicuspid aortic valve
 - Ventricular septal defects
 - Atrial septal defects
